

PARENT PARTICIPATION

PHILOSOPHY AND GOALS

Chibi-Chan Preschool offers a nurturing and stimulating environment for children age 2 to 5 years old. At Chibi-Chan, we believe in the process of developmental stages, and we introduce new concepts according to each child's ability and age. The curriculum is enriched with exciting themes, including multicultural concepts that are explored through play, arts and crafts, cooking, dance, music, social studies, reading, science, and language development activities. Each hands-on activity helps to enhance the development of cognitive, social, emotional and physical readiness skills.

We also believe in creating an environment that fosters independence by giving children opportunities to make decisions on their own, as well as exposing them to a diverse array of experiences to establish the foundation for future learning.

In 2007, Chibichan Preschool was selected as a Preschool For All (PFA) site. PFA is a new city initiative, implemented by First 5 San Francisco in partnership with Wu Yee Children's Services, which ultimately provides universal access to high quality, free part-day preschool programs to all San Francisco four-year-olds. Participating children will receive free part-day preschool (3.5 hours/day) off the school's regular tuition rate. **Please inquire about Preschool For All (PFA) tuition rates

DAILY SCHEDULE

Hours of Operation: Monday to Friday
7:30 AM to 6:00 PM

The school is divided into 3 classrooms: young 2-3 year-olds (Classroom C), young 3-4 year-olds (Classroom B), and older 4-5 year-olds (Classroom A).

AFTERNOON

1:00-3:00p	Nap Time (Soft music/story for transition time)
3:00-3:30p	Afternoon snack (Crackers, fruit, cookies, etc.)
3:30-4:00p	Child-Directed Play: Indoor
4:00-5:00p	Outside Time (Combine Class A, B, & C)
5:00-6:00p	Departure (Quiet play, stories, Puzzles, blocks, art)

PROGRAM

Aimed at children 2 to 5 years old, Chibi-Chan enhances a child's total development:

- 1. Cognitive Development:**
Emphasize problem solving, communication, discovery, and active learning.
- 2. Physical Development:**
Improve gross motor and fine motor skills.
- 3. Social/Emotional Development:**
Nurture positive self-esteem: value all cultures and backgrounds, and respect others' feelings.
- 4. Creative Expression:**
Provide a wide range of expression through art, music, dance, fantasy and play.

NAP TIME

Our nap-time/rest period is 1:00 – 3:00 pm. Each child needs a blanket (clearly labeled) and may bring a small stuffed animal to cuddle with. We will send blankets home every other week to be washed.

SUMMER PROGRAM

Introduced in 1998, our summer program exposes children to the wonders of their surrounding environment and diverse community. During July and August, the program offers weekly field trips, park day, and theme-based days such as cooking day, science day, dramatic play day, and multicultural day.
